



## **Action Plan Month April 2022 to March 2023**

Under the Indian Constitution, social, economic and political justice has been ensured to all the citizens of India. In the absence of proper knowledge of rights and economic means, a large section of the society and especially the deprived and needy people are not able to get justice. The denial of justice to the people of the society on the basis of the above shortcomings shows that in order to achieve the objective of the constitution, every organ of the government needs to work in a coordinated manner, so that not only the deprived and needy people of the society get the right to live with human dignity, but they will also get ample amount of opportunity to contribute to the development of the country. The purpose of the presented action plan is to provide benefits to the backward and deprived people of the society according to the schemes and instructions of NALSA, SLISA and government and at the same time not only to make people aware of their rights in the society, but also to make sure that every person of the society is aware about their fundamental duties.

The action plan year 2022-23 is specially focused upon legal provisions related with children so that they could take advantage of government schemes made for upliftment of adolescents and children with special abilities, education treatment, re-admission of school dropouts, education of children who have lost their parents in Covid-19, maintenance etc. for the purpose of providing benefits of schemes and their rehabilitation.

Under the action plan, special days are to be organized every month and also for people belonging to special class and area programmes are to be organized keeping in mind adaptability to the situation according to schemes of NALSA and government every month and week respectively. Targets have been fixed for each scheme, the objective of which is to ensure the progress of each scheme with equal focus on the plan which is being implemented.

The main objective of the Legal Services Authority is to provide free legal aid, spread legal literacy, organize Lok Adalat to encourage settlement of disputes and promote use of alternative dispute resolution techniques to resolve disputes and to provide compensation to the victims of crime etc.

Keeping in view the above objectives, under the action plan year 2022-23, the following activities are proposed to be organized along with other ongoing schemes & instructions issued from time to time by the National Legal Services Authority and State Legal Services Authority etc.

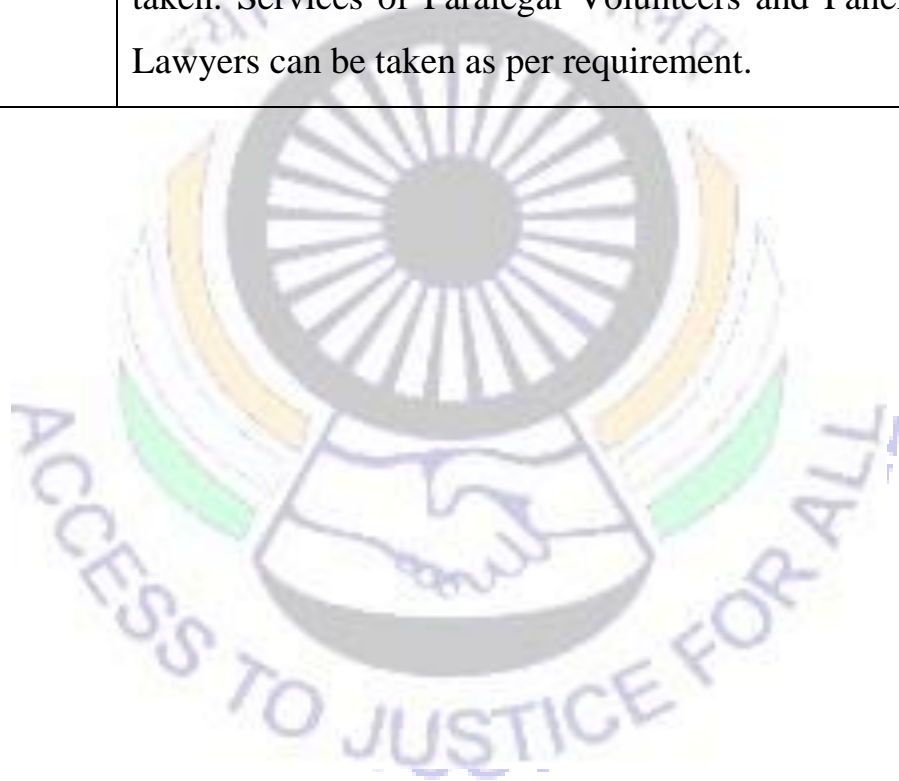

## **Target to be achieved under NALSA and MPSSLA Schemes for the year 2022-23**

The following targets have been set by the M.P. State Legal Services Authority for the year 2022-23 to be achieved by all District Legal Services Authorities and Tehsil Legal Services Committees:-

**1) Legal Aid and Legal Advice Scheme:** - To benefit maximum number of persons at district and tehsil level under the Legal Aid and Advice Scheme.

**2) Lok Adalat:-** Lok Adalats will be organized at district and tehsil level as follows:-

**3) Litigation Free Village Scheme:-** Every district will try to achieve the target of at least 02 litigation free villages including Tehsils falling under it according to the scheme.

**4) District Legal Counseling Center Scheme:-** Persons who are deprived of their legal and legal rights or who need any legal advice, District Legal Counseling Center is there to solve their problems by giving free legal advice to such persons.

The disputes of the parties are to be settled through mutual consultations and agreements through DLSA. For this, every month at least 05 cases at district level, 02 at tehsil level will be resolved in consultation. The implementation of this scheme has been inactive over the years. Therefore, by reactivating it, maximum number of common people have to be benefited.

**5) Family Dispute Resolution Center Scheme: -** Beginning from April 2022 till March 2023 at least 05 persons at district level and at least 3 persons at tehsil level are to be benefitted every month under the scheme. The implementation of the scheme has been inactive over the years. Therefore, by reactivating it, maximum number of common people have to be benefited.

**6) Remand Advocate Scheme in Magistrate Courts:-** DLSA provides legal aid to the remand stage prisoners in Magistrate Courts in the form of pleading in remand cases and bail application by appointing panel advocates. The progress of the last year under this scheme is not very encouraging, so there is a need to give more boost to this scheme. In the month of April 2022 to March 2023, efforts should be made to give maximum benefit to the detained prisoners by giving wide publicity to this scheme.

**7) Legal Aid Clinics:-** As per the directions of NALSA, a total of 1097 Legal Aid Clinics have been established in all the 50 districts of the State Authority. Target is set to establish Legal Aid Clinics in all Children Homes, Swadhar Grah, Old Age Homes, Schools, Colleges, Mental Hospitals, Gram Panchayats, Jails and Community Centres across the state.

**8) Crime against labor cell: -** In relation to effective implementation of labor laws, protection of labor workers, getting them fixed wages, discrimination against women workers and preventing them from sexual harassment and preventing

children from working as laborers And in order to provide justice to the beneficiary, **Crime against labor cell** has been constituted in each district across the State under the Chairmanship of the Principal District Judge. Implementation of this scheme is largely inactive in the last years. Therefore, by reactivating it, reviewing the activities conducted monthly, maximum number of workers could be benefitted.

**9) Women and Child Protection Unit:-** A "Women and Child Protection Unit" has been constituted at each district under the chairmanship of the Principal District Judge with the objective of resolving the problems related to women and children and providing them speedy justice. Implementation of this scheme inactive in the last years. Therefore, by reactivating it, reviewing the activities conducted monthly, so that maximum number of workers could be benefitted.

**10) Special Camps, Review Meetings, Training and Inspection Programs:-** Employment guarantee camps, small and large literacy camps will be included in organizing these camps.

Such special camps should be organized every month and in these camps the disadvantaged communities (including transgender, AIDS victims) should be made aware of their rights as well as the right to free legal aid available to them.

Regular training programs should be organized to sensitize paralegal volunteers and panel Advocates. At least 02 monitoring meetings of Paralegal Volunteers and Panel Lawyers should be organized by the District Legal Services Authority every month through online or offline mode.

The report should be prepared by the district authority along with the deficiencies and suggestions and action should be taken at the district level, through monitoring cell meetings and other appropriate means, to make up for the deficiencies.

Monthly Review the actions taken under Victim Compensation Scheme and take appropriate steps to resolve maximum number of cases.

All the schemes of NALSA run by the National Legal Services Authority, New Delhi can be implemented jointly with the schemes run by the State Authority.

In the month of April 2022 to March 2023 also, try to provide benefits to the above persons by giving wide publicity through the camp of NALSA schemes.

**Note:-** Action will be taken by each District Legal Services Authority by creating a profile on YouTube, Twitter, Facebook and other social media for wide publicity regarding the activities conducted. Radio, live broadcasting, and other similar mediums can also be used in a proper way for publicity.

While reviewing the actions being taken under Victim Compensation Scheme monthly, appropriate action should be taken to resolve maximum number of cases.

**11) Mediation Awareness Program:-** Organizing a mediation awareness program at district/family court/tehsil level every month as per the action plan sent separately for mediation.

**12) Legal Literacy Camp Scheme:-** Organized legal literacy camps at each district and tehsil level.

In these camps, at least one camp must be organized under all the schemes of NALSA, including one or more schemes of NALSA.

Camps organized at the district headquarters level will be organized after wide publicity in which more attention will be given to local issues. For this, the cooperation of the concerned district and tehsil's panel advocate and NGO, Paralegal Volunteers will be taken.

**13) Special Programme by District Legal Services Authority:-** Madhya Pradesh is a vast land area, where its special problems and situations exist in different areas. Keeping in view the problems of the people residing in the area and their



circumstances, the District Legal Services Authority for the area on any specific topic which is related to the schemes of NALSA and Salsa or for the upliftment of the deprived and needy people of the society (Upliftment) or Hon'ble Court It can be done on the subject related to the instructions given by it, after preparing an action plan for the program, after approval from the State Legal Services Authority, can do a program on the said subject.

**14) Wide Publicity:-** Wide publicity of legal service activities, schemes of NALSA and SLSA, special campaigns and success stories through print and electronic media, radio, TV, cable, social media, flex banners, pamphlets, brochures, street plays, rallies etc. to be disseminated.

For District Legal Services Authority and Tehsil Legal Services Committees, the monthly progress sheets of the schemes should be sent as per the pre-determined instructions, after ensuring the fulfillment of the targets set as above.

The bills of office plans and all office expenses should be paid regularly every month and the bills are to be sent to the M.P. State Legal Services Authority, Jabalpur should also be verified within the stipulated time period and sent to this office.

**Note:-** Programs organized on subjects other than those mentioned in the Action Plan 2022-23 will continue to be conducted as per the earlier instructions or as per the instructions issued from time to time.

**Important instructions for effective work plan:-**

1. For the implementation of the action plan, advance action plan will be prepared by the District Legal Services Authority for the activities mentioned in the action plan of each month and according to the action plan, the program will be conducted informing all the concerned departments etc.
2. Coordination should be maintained with all the concerned government departments, voluntary organizations and other concerned. Discussions should be held with them in order to ensure practical results with mutual

consent. Their full cooperation can be taken in the activities according to the action plan and according to local conditions.

3. The program mentioned in the action plan for which the date has not been fixed, the District Legal Services Authority can take action by fixing the date of the program etc. for the activities mentioned in the action plan according to the local circumstances.
4. If there is a need to make changes in the pre-determined date in the action plan according to the local situation, the Hon'ble President / Principal District Judge, District Legal Services Authority, considering the overall circumstances, informing the M.P. State Legal Services Authority, Jabalpur, shall fix a new date and after the program, information about the activities can be sent as per the earlier instructions.
5. According to the action plan 2022-23, the information of the program which is to be organized must be sent to the MP State Legal Services Authority by the 1<sup>st</sup> of every month with a brief description in which success story, photographs, newspaper cuttings etc. can be included.
